PART E – SPECIFICATIONS

- Revise: E2.8 to read: Work must commence for Police Service calls within forty-five (45) minutes; Winnipeg Fire Paramedics Services within one (1) hour of notification, or where otherwise agreed at time of the call.
- Revise: E3.4 to read: Labour and material for basement and main floor board up (all inclusive) (8:00 am to 6:00 pm Working days).
- Delete: E3.7
- Revise: E3.9 to read: Labour and material for basement and main floor board up (all inclusive) (6:01 pm to 7.59 am including weekends, Statutory and Civic holidays).
- Delete: E3.12
- Revise: E3.15 to read: Supply, installation, and removal of temporary fencing shall be wire mesh linear fence panels a minimum of 72" high x 10' length. Fencing shall be supported by ground bases between each panel as necessary to maintain strength, uniformity and taughtness. Rental cost shall be calculated per panel per four (4) week rental commencing on date of installation.
- Revise: E3.16 to read: Supply and install access panel, chain and keys. When directed by officer in charge, assemble one panel of the fence as an access panel. One end will be supported at the ground base to act as a swivel. The other end of the panel will not be supported at the ground base but it will be secured with a chain and padlock. The chain shall be ¼" Zinc-

Plated (to resist corrosion) proof tested coil chain. Padlock shall be stainless steel with a weather resistant thermoplastic shell and cap to cover keyhole for outdoor protection. Keys shall be provided to the By-law Enforcement Officer or personally delivered to 395 Main Street during normal business hours.
