Winnipeg Police Service Hearing Standards

- No restrictions needed form hearing-dependent tasks if, on audiometric testing, all pure tone thresholds are 25 dB or less in each ear at each frequency 500, 1000, 2000, 3000 Hz.
- Will need restrictions from hearing-dependent tasks, if on audiometric testing, the pure-tone threshold in the better ear is greater than an average of 40dB over 500, 1000, and 2,000 Hz, with or without a hearing aid.
- Complete In-Canal hearing aides are acceptable if the hearing loss is corrected to no greater than 25 dB in each ear at each frequency 500, 1000, 2000, 3000 Hz.
