

List of accepted items at all 4R Winnipeg Depots.

Below are the following items you can drop off at all 4R Winnipeg Depot locations. Depending upon availability, this list may grow or change.

Household Hazardous and Special Waste	
Batteries	Single-use, rechargeable, automotive
Electronic waste	Televisions, computers and computer equipment, audio and video equipment, phones, cell phones, microwaves
Household hazardous waste	Household cleaners and chemicals, fluorescent lights, propane tanks, paint, herbicides/pesticides, aerosols
Automotive fluids	Motor oil, antifreeze, oil filters, and oil containers

Bicycles	
Blue cart recyclables	Newspaper, household paper, flattened cardboard, empty plastic containers, empty metal cans - no black plastics
Ceramics	Dishes, tiles, sinks, toilets
Clean fill	Soil, sod, clay, sand
Clean lumber	Non-treated/unpainted lumber, wood, off cuts, pallets
Glass	Empty bottles and jars, windows without frames, glassware, broken glass
Large appliances	Stoves, fridges, freezers, washers, dryers, water coolers, air conditioner units, dishwashers
Large plastics	Buckets, plant pots, storage containers, plastic patio furniture, laundry baskets – no metal components, tarps or bags, no black plastics

Rubble and masonry	Brick, asphalt, patio stones, gravel, concrete – no rebar
Tires	Both with or without rims on them
Scrap metal	Small appliances, pots, pans, chain link fencing, BBQs, snow blowers, lawn mowers, power tools
Branches and brush	Branches less than 10 centimetres in diameter
Leaves and grass clippings	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Material can be loose, but must be unloaded manually into a bin at the depot • If contained, must be in a brown paper yard waste bag or cardboard box (no plastic bags)
