

## List of accepted items at all 4R Winnipeg Depots.

Below are the following items you can drop off at all 4R Winnipeg Depot locations. Depending upon availability, this list may grow or change.

<b>Household Hazardous and Special Waste</b>	
<b>Batteries</b>	Single-use, rechargeable, automotive
<b>Electronic waste</b>	Televisions, computers and computer equipment, audio and video equipment, phones, cell phones, microwaves
<b>Household hazardous waste</b>	Accepted items must be in its original packaging. The item must have one industry hazardous symbol. This includes: household cleaners and chemicals, fluorescent lights, propane tanks, paint, herbicides/pesticides, aerosols.
<b>Automotive fluids</b>	Motor oil, antifreeze, oil filters, and oil containers
<b>Recycling and reuse</b>	
<b>Bicycles</b>	
<b>Blue cart recyclables</b>	Newspaper, household paper, flattened cardboard, empty plastic containers, empty metal cans - no black plastics
<b>Ceramics</b>	Dishes, tiles, sinks, toilets
<b>Clean fill</b>	Soil, sod, clay, sand
<b>Clean lumber</b>	Non-treated/unpainted lumber, wood, off cuts, pallets
<b>Glass</b>	Empty bottles and jars, windows without frames, glassware, broken glass
<b>Large appliances</b>	Stoves, fridges, freezers, washers, dryers, water coolers, air conditioner units, dishwashers
<b>Large plastics</b>	Buckets, plant pots, storage containers, plastic patio furniture, laundry baskets – no metal components, tarps or bags, no black plastics

<b>Rubble and masonry</b>	Brick, asphalt, patio stones, gravel, concrete – no rebar
<b>Tires</b>	Both with or without rims on them
<b>Scrap metal</b>	Small appliances, pots, pans, chain link fencing, BBQs, snow blowers, lawn mowers, power tools
<b>Branches and brush</b>	Branches less than 10 centimetres in diameter
<b>Leaves and grass clippings</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Material can be loose, but must be unloaded manually into a bin at the depot</li> <li>• If contained, must be in a brown paper yard waste bag or cardboard box (no plastic bags)</li> </ul>
