About the program

Small commercial customers can apply to use the household hazard waste and blue cart recyclables areas at 4R Winnipeg Depots . There is a limit to the amount of materials that can be dropped off. The volume of materials customers drop off must be on par with that of a residential household. There’s an annual fee for this program.

Accepted materials

Small commercial customers can only visit the household hazardous waste building and blue cart recyclables areas. They can only bring these materials in their original containers with legible labels:

- Household chemicals
- Fluorescent lights
- Propane tanks
- Paint
- Herbicides/pesticides
- Flammable liquids
- Oil
- Batteries
- Newspaper
- Household paper
- Empty & flattened cardboard
- Empty plastic containers
- Empty metal cans
- Empty glass bottles/jars
