TO: BUSINESSES / RESIDENTS

RE: 2022 MUNROE AVENUE PAVEMENT RENEWAL – WATT STREET TO RALEIGH STREET

Please be advised Munroe Avenue from Watt Street to Raleigh Street is scheduled for a pavement renewal project in Spring 2022.

Construction start: May 2022 Duration: 12 weeks

The proposed work will include: drainage infrastructure improvements; concrete pavement reconstruction; sidewalk reconstruction; private approach renewals; geometric improvements of the Munroe Avenue/Watt Street intersection; and traffic signal upgrades.

Construction will have an impact on traffic, parking, pedestrians, and access. Details and instructions regarding construction and traffic staging, access impacts, parking, pedestrian accommodations, and garbage/recycling collection will be provided in a second notice issued approximately one week prior to construction.

If you have accessibility concerns, special access requirements, planned special events, known underground appurtenances such as sprinklers or lighting cables within 6m of the Munroe Avenue curb line, or any other questions regarding this construction, please contact Kelly Groff at Kelly.Groff@wsp.com.
