



## SAGIMAY TRAIL

The Sagimay trail includes both a fully accessible 1.5km paved loop, as well as a wood chipped section around the perimeter of the Eve Werier Memorial Pond which includes a boardwalk through a wetland environment.

## PRESTON TRAIL

The Preston Trail is composed of granular limestone and features pathways through some of the forest's linear cuts as well as a constructed wetland and restored tall grass prairie.

**2.2KM TOTAL**

## OAK RIDGE TRAIL

The Oak Ridge Trail covers the northern area of the forest, and moves through mixed aspen/oak climate environments. It is composed of wood chips for most of its length, except where it follows the Preston trail along its western edge.

**1.5KM TOTAL**

## HARTE TRAIL

The Harte Trail is part of the Trans Canada Trail, and is also composed of granular limestone. The Assiniboine Forest section of the trail runs along an old railway bed along its southern edge.

## TRAVERSE TRAIL

The Traverse Trail bisects the forest and connects the eastern and western communities that border it. The trail is composed of wood chips, and connects to both the Sagimay and Preston trails.

**1.3KM TOTAL**

## ASPEN TRAIL

The Aspen Trail is a wood chip trail that acts as a north-south connection between the Sagimay and Harte Trails. Moving through the aspen forest, it also intersects with the Traverse Trail.
