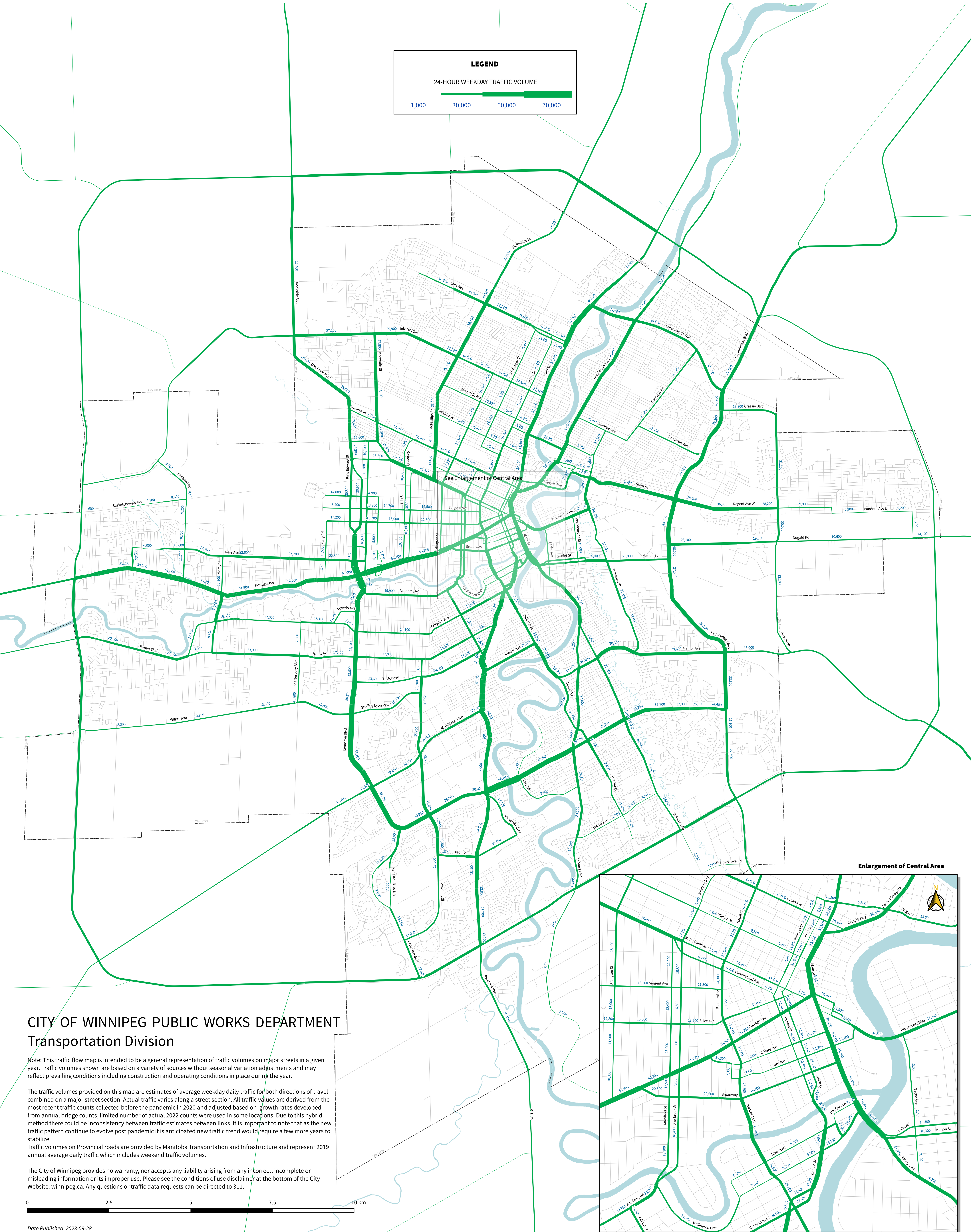
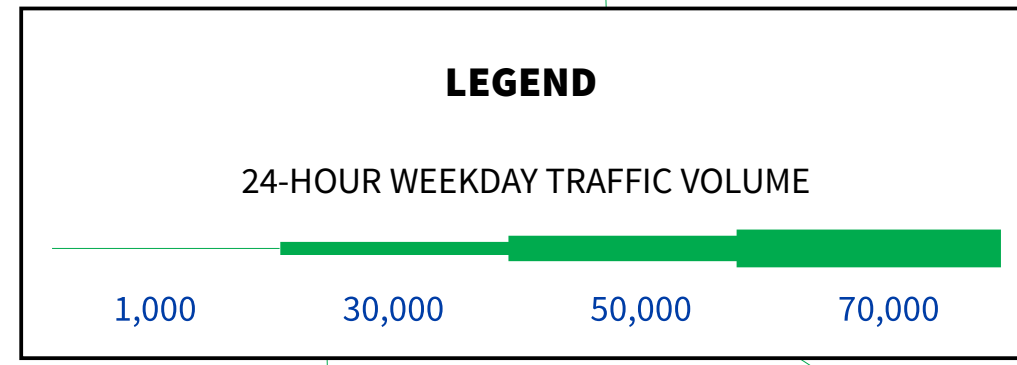
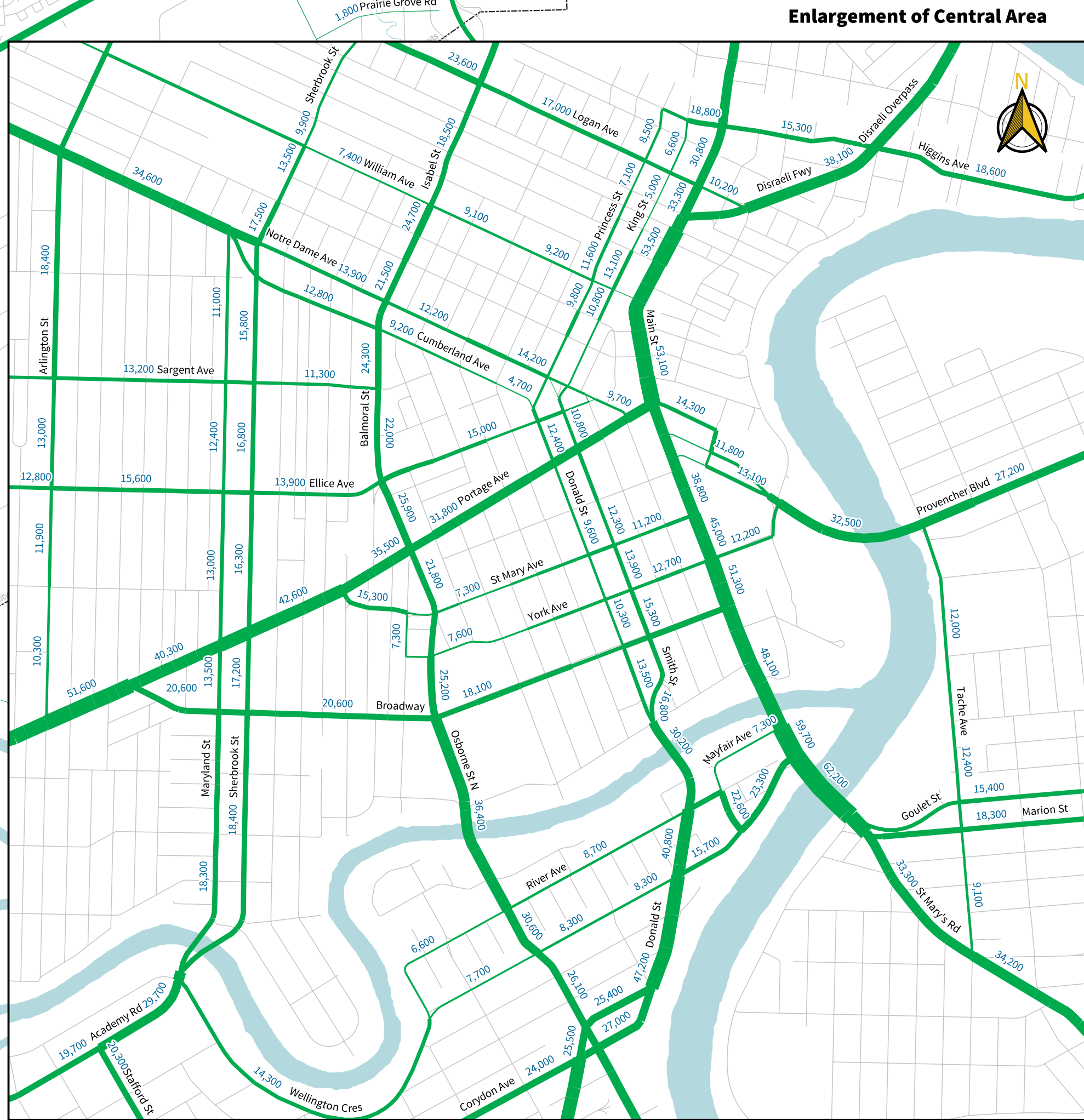


2022 Traffic Flow Map

Note: This traffic flow map is intended to be a general representation of traffic volumes on major streets in a given year. Traffic volumes shown are based on a variety of sources without seasonal variation adjustments and may reflect prevailing conditions including construction and operating conditions in place during the year.

The traffic volumes provided on this map are estimates of average weekday daily traffic for both directions of travel combined on a major street section. Actual traffic varies along a street section. All traffic values are derived from the most recent traffic counts collected before the pandemic in 2020 and adjusted based on growth rates developed from annual bridge counts, limited number of actual 2022 counts were used in some locations. Due to this hybrid method there could be inconsistency between traffic estimates between links. It is important to note that as the new traffic pattern continue to evolve post pandemic it is anticipated new traffic trend would require a few more years to stabilize.

Traffic volumes on Provincial roads are provided by Manitoba Transportation and Infrastructure and represent 2019 annual average daily traffic which includes weekend traffic volumes.

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
