COMMUNITY COMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION:

On February 3, 2020, the Riel Community Committee passed the following motion:

WHEREAS development along the west side of St. Mary's Road between Van Hull Way /
Warde Avenue and Britannica Road has saturated the area with multi-family dwellings;

AND WHEREAS residents on the west side of St. Mary's Road continue to access the east side
of St. Mary's road for services and recreational opportunities;

AND WHEREAS development on the west side of this 1 km section of St Mary's Road has not
included an overhead flashing beacon system for access to the east side of St. Mary's Road;

AND WHEREAS residents have expressed significant concerns with respect to the increased
volume of traffic along St Mary's Road between the Perimeter Highway and Bishop Grandin
Boulevard (not limited to the development on the west side of St. Mary's Road);

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Standing Policy Committee on Infrastructure
Renewal and Public Works be requested to direct the Winnipeg Public Service to report back
within 120 days on the following:

1. Recommended traffic calming measures along St. Mary's Road between Van Hull
Way and Britannica Road;
2. The installation of an overhead flashing beacon system adjacent to the entrance of
Henteleff Park.
