#### A Message from the Chief of Police



Danny G. Smyth Chief of Police

The Winnipeg Police Service 2020 Statistical Report reflects the crime that was reported in Winnipeg, but it only tells part of the story in what was a remarkable year that saw the city deal with the effects of the COVID-19 virus.

There were several interesting dynamics observed in 2020:

Calls to our Communications Centre dropped by almost 6%, yet the total number of calls dispatched increased. Of the calls dispatched, the number of Check Wellbeing incidents increased by 12%, surpassing Domestic

incidents as the most dispatched event. While COVID-19 might be a causal factor in these changes, it will likely be another year before we see the full effects of the pandemic on police operations.

Property crime was significantly reduced compared to the previous year, with fewer reports of break & enter, shoplifting and theft under \$5000 being reported. There was a dramatic decrease in the number of liquor store thefts, primarily driven by the implementation of security protocols by the Manitoba Liquor & Lotteries.

There was a modest decrease in violent crimes, driven primarily by a reduction in all robberies. However, the number of homicides was quite high for the second year in a row. I do note some cause for concern regarding the increase in assault with a weapon offences, and in particular, the number of knife related events.

As a police service we strive to have a workforce that is reflective of the community we serve. Throughout the pandemic we made the most of the resources we had, providing a balanced and strategic approach to manage a challenging environment.

I would like to take this opportunity to thank all members of the Winnipeg Police Service for their dedication and commitment to the citizens of Winnipeg during the pandemic.



#### **Policing per Capita Cost**






















#### **Sexual Assaults by Location**



PORTAGE AVE ZONES CRIMES BY DISTRICT PORTAGE AVE ZONES





#### Persons Charged by District






















## Citizen-generated Dispatched Events by Day











#### **Police-initiated Events Trend**





Data were compiled in accordance with violent crimes (i.e. most serious violation against the victim), property crimes, and other crimes (i.e. first violation) scoring rules.
