To further protect our wastewater, land drainage and river systems, we are recommending stricter requirements in the Sewer By-law.

Winnipeg residents are invited to review

Proposed changes to the Sewer By-law

The requirements will apply to all users of the sewer system, and will include:

- new restrictions on substances that can be put down the drain (e.g., prescribed and over-the-counter medication, toxic substances)
- a new licence for grease traps in food service establishments
- a pollution prevention plan for businesses that put prohibited or restricted substances down the drain, starting with metal finishing companies
- new charges for businesses that put nitrogen or phosphorus down the drain in amounts that are over the By-law limit
- clearer restrictions on draining swimming pool water
